

1 Q. Right.

2 A. I would say I was doing 8 percent clear
3 lensectomy with interocular lens implantation. About
4 ten percent astigmatic keratotomy, 5 percent radial
keratotomy, and the balance lasik.

5 Q. Okay. Can you tell me looking at your CV now
6 what do you do as a clinical instructor at University
7 of Pennsylvania? Actually, let me ask you this, were
8 you a clinical instructor at the University of
9 Pennsylvania in 1997?

10 A. Yes.
